SCHOLARSHIP

DETAILS

Scholarships worth \$1000 and \$2000 are available to two post-secondary students entering the second, third, or fourth year of an undergraduate program, or any stage of a graduate program, whose education and career goals are related to mental health promotion.

MANDATORY BASIC CRITERIA

- Have lived or living experience with mental health illness
- At least 20 years old
- Lives in BC or intends to live in BC for the duration of the school year
- Completion of the first year of undergraduate program (and entering 2nd, 3rd or 4th year) or any stage of graduate program
- Attending a public or private university, college or technology institute located in British Columbia
- All questions answered
- Letter of intent attached (500 words maximum)
- No more than two additional pages of supporting documents (i.e. one page front and back or two pages single-sided)
- Two references and financial information attached

Please **note** that those applicants who have won the award in the past two years are not eligible to apply again this year.

****Additional points will be given according to how well each question is answered as well as the quality of details and information provided. We will be looking for applicants who provide strong and thoughtful examples and supporting details as well as tell us their story in each answer.**

MANDATORY: A history of mental illness ¹ If this criterion is not met, application is disregarded.	Yes/No
Additional points for describing how mental illness has affected and/or influenced education.	/15

EDUCATION AND CAREER GOALS

Criteria	Score
MANDATORY: Having career goal(s) identified and connection made to course/program	/20
Additional points for a clear passion about this career goal	/5
Additional points for a demonstrated interest, aptitude or experience in the chosen career (i.e., the applicant could cite previous training, list specific character traits or relate certain skilled hobbies)	/5

STATEMENT OF INTENT

/25

Criteria	Score
MANDATORY: Educational and vocational goals must be related to mental health promotion (letter must be no longer than 500 words)	/10
Additional points if: <ul style="list-style-type: none">the path toward achieving the specified education goal is clearly outlinedmotivations, aptitudes and/or achievements are describedmental illness is described as both a barrier and an asset for the fulfillment of the educational goal	/15

MANDATORY: Two non-family references.	Disqualified if criteria not met
Additional points for detailed and specific examples	/5
Additional points if referee knows applicant well and has been acquainted with applicant in the past year	/5
Additional points for the referee’s enthusiasm for the applicant’s personal strength, resilience, readiness for the course, and/or likelihood of success (i.e., not a receipt of medical treatment, an iteration of mental health history, or a re-statement of applicant’s request)	/5
